EIS VLF envisages to establish learning connections with all the students by taking a front seat and kick started the Academic year on 14th June'21







#### Constitution day

#### November 26 1950

Constitution day is celebrated every year on 26 November to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India by the Constituent Assembly in 1949. It was drafted by a six-member committee headed by Dr. BR Ambedkar.

The nation will celebrate Constitution Day on 26th November to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India by the Constituent Assembly in 1949. It was drafted by a six-member committee headed by Dr. BR Ambedkar. The observation of Constitution Day of India started in 2015, based on the vision of the Prime Minister to give due recognition to the significance of this historic date. The roots of this vision can also be traced back to the "Samvidhan Gaurav Yatra" organised by the then Gujarat Chief Minister Shri Narendra Modi in 2010.

PM Modi, on Constitution Day, will participate in the programmes being organised in Parliament and Vigyan Bhawan on 26th November, 2021.

The programme organized in Parliament will begin at 11 AM and will be held in the Central Hall of Parliament. It will be addressed by the Hon'ble President, Vice President, Prime Minister and Lok Sabha Speaker. After the speech of the Hon'ble President, the nation will join him Live, in reading the Preamble of the Constitution. Hon'ble President will also release the digital version of Constituent Assembly Debates, digital version of calligraphed copy of Constitution of India and updated version of the Constitution of India that will include all amendments till date. He will also inaugurate 'Online Quiz on Constitutional Democracy'.

Prime Minister will inaugurate the two-day Constitution Day celebrations organised by the Supreme Court, at 5:30 PM in Plenary Hall, Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. All Judges of the Supreme Court, Chief Justices of all High Courts and senior-most puisne Judges. Solicitor General of India, and other members of the legal fraternity will be present on the occasion. Prime Minister will also address the distinguished gathering. Constitution Day (or Samvidhan Divas), also known as National Law Day, is celebrated in India on 26 November 1949 every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On 26 November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted to the Constitution of India, and it came into effect on 26 January 1950. The Government of India declared 26 November as Constitution Day on 19 November 2015 by a gazette notification. The Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi made the declaration on 11 October 2015 while laying the foundation stone of the B. R. Ambedkar's Statue of Equality memorial in Mumbai. The year of 2021 was the 131th birth anniversary of Ambedkar, who had chaired the drafting committee of the Constituent Assembly and played a pivotal role in the drafting of the constitution. Previously this day was celebrated as Law Day. 26 November was chosen to spread the importance of the constitution and to spread thoughts and ideas of Ambedkar. Constitution Day is not a public holiday. Various departments of the Government of India celebrated the first Constitution Day. As per the Department of Education and Literacy, the preamble of the constitution was read in all schools by all students. In addition, there were quiz and essay competitions both online and offline on the subject of the constitution of India. There was a lecture on salient features of the constitution in each school. The Department of Higher Education requested various universities to arrange mock parliamentary debates in colleges, and the University Grants Commission (UGC) arranged an all-India quiz competition at Ambedkar University, Lucknow, where guiz winners of all states participated.

## New Education Policy Foundation Stone For Naya Bharat

The recently revised National Education Policy2020 has got everyone talking. And why not? It does bring major changes in the system of education and a new perspective to view learning as a whole. It is one of the most revolutionary steps for the education sector of India. From early-learning to adult schools, and modular assessments to option for study gaps, the NEP is made keeping in mind every age group and every mind . The government aims to bridge social gaps in participation, access, and learning outcomes in school education As our Prime Minister <u>Narendra Modi</u> says, "New Education Policy aims at making job creators and not job seekers". This policy has the power to change the dynamic of education in India. It has received several responses, mostly positive, along with some thought provoking questions. However, there is the bigger picture of implementation which will define the success of this policy.

#### Impact of NEP 2020 on Indian education system

### 1.Content Curriculum and Pedagogy

To implement this change at grassroots levels, curriculum, content, and pedagogy restructuring must be done as per the NCF (National Curriculum Framework) and content revisited in textbooks.

#### 2. Integrate Technology with Learning and Teaching Process A regulatory body NEAT (National Educational Alliance for Technology) has been set up to integrate

A regulatory body NEAT (National Educational Alliance for Technology) has been set up to integrate technology for better learning outcomes. NEAT aims to use Artificial Intelligence to personalize learning experience depending on learner's requirement.

It even proposes to extend national alliance interests with EdTech companies for enhanced learning outcomes.

However, one of the biggest challenges is to establish a robust digital infrastructure in remote areas.

#### 3. Assessment

PARAKH (Performance Assessment, Review, and Analysis of Knowledge for Holistic Development), a national assessment centre has been proposed to set up to keep a regular check on the education system.

NEP2020 aims to recognise the need to evaluate "higher order skills" such as creativity, critical thinking, problem solving, visualisation, and idea generation.

Shifting the focus of assessments from academic grades to higher order skills creates higher performance standards demonstrated through varying degrees of competency across social levels.

## 4. Mother Tongue as a medium of instruction

NEP 2020 focuses on the use of mother tongue as the instruction medium however, not mandating the use of a particular language on anyone.

Home language or local language will be used preferably till Grade 8 as mother tongue lets students grasp complex concepts easily When the medium of instruction is the mother tongue or local language. This extends to parental participation in schooling, as well. In India, due to a lack of fluency in English, parental participation is sometimes limited.

### 5. Science, Arts and Commerce gets blurred


NEP 2020 emphasises on multidisciplinary learning and no separations are made between vocational and academic streams. There are infinite online learning platforms offer access to multi-disciplinary modules that help users to build unique careers for future jobs.
