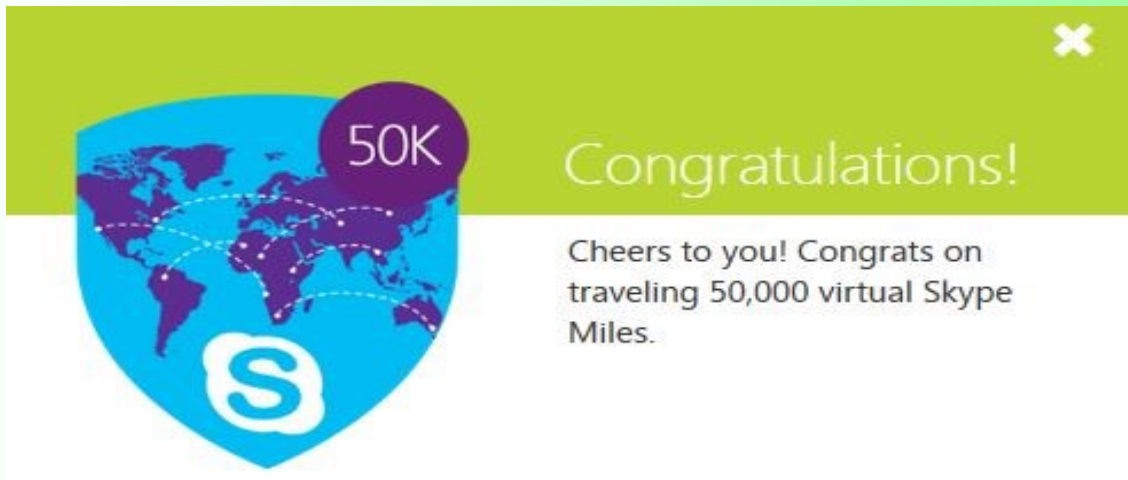
## “ Microsoft Global Learning Connections.”

HOC is a global movement introducing tens of millions of students worldwide to computer science, inspiring kids to learn more, breaking stereotypes, and leaving them feeling empowered.

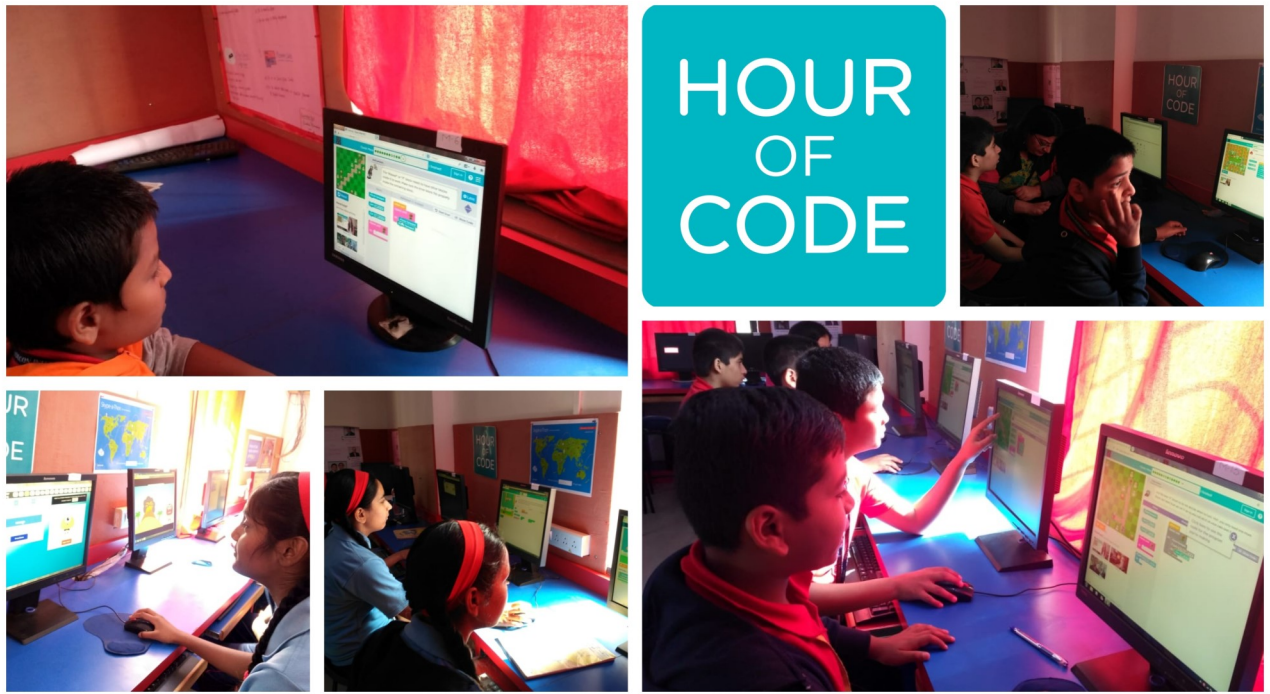

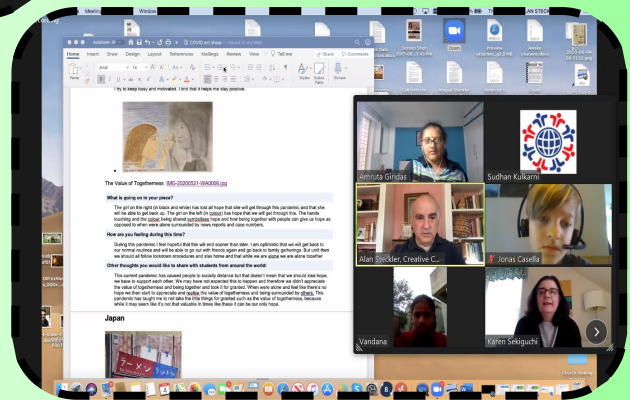
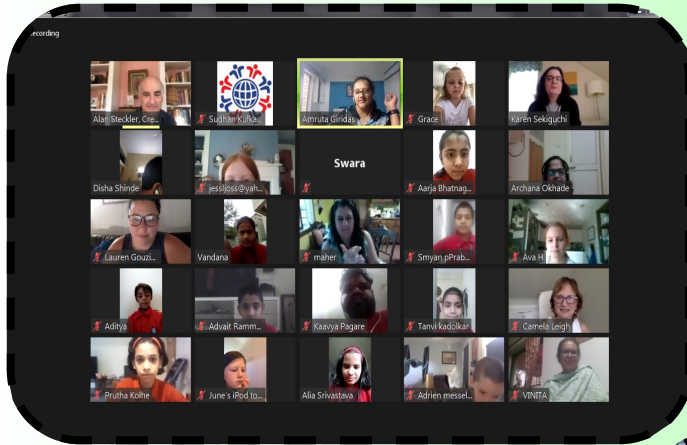
ARTLINK PROGRAM :

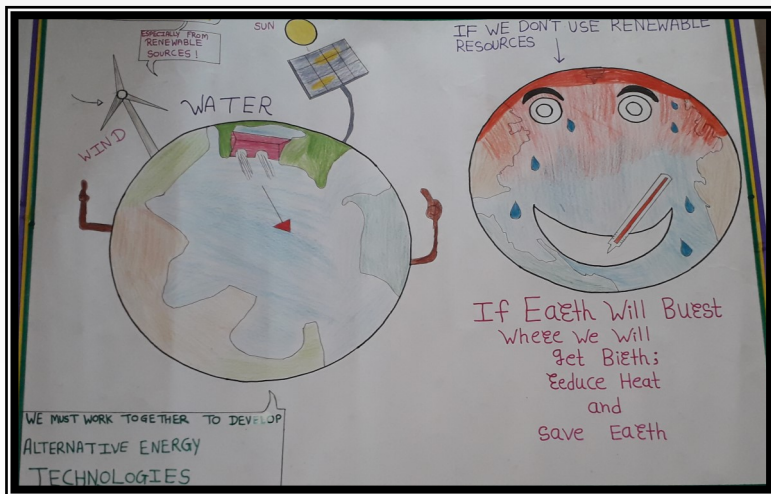

# FIELD TRIPS



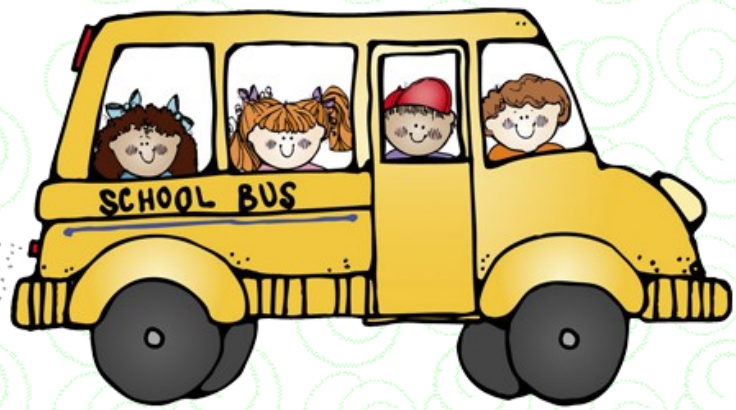
## Field Trips - Commissioner Office , Space Park
